### M/Y Eclipse 8-Day Cruises



The M/Y Eclipse is considered one of the finest boutique cruise ships in the Galapagos Islands, offering unparalleled levels of comfort and service. She was converted specifically for upscale cruising in the islands, and was designed to meet the exacting

demands of luxury travel. Ships the size of the *Eclipse* would normally accommodate many more passengers, and she offers the generous accommodation of a larger vessel, while preserving the atmosphere and exclusivity of a smaller yacht. The *Eclipse* is a 210-foot expedition vessel that accommodates up to 48 passengers in fully air-conditioned staterooms with windows and ocean views. There is a well-equipped lounge for relaxation and the nightly briefings on the day's discoveries and the following day's activities. In addition to the elegant indoor dining room, there is an *al fresco* dining area located around the pool. The Boat Deck Suites are 210 sq. ft. and have a queen beds, convertible sofa-beds and private bathrooms with bathtubs. The Boat Deck Staterooms and the Double Deluxe Main Deck cabins are 170 sq. ft. and include guest chairs and have either one queen or two twin beds, and private bathrooms with showers.

The M/Y Millenium is the most elegant catamaran in the Galapagos Islands. A catamaran affords greater stability, and therefore, the greatest safety and comfort of the smaller ships. The cabins and public rooms

are also spacious because of the catamaran-style hull. She is 82 feet long, with a 33-foot beam, and cruises at 12 knots, powered by twin 82-horsepower engines. She accommodates up to 16 passengers in eight spacious cabins, all with lower berths and private bathrooms with bathtubs. Six of the cabins have twin berths and two cabins have king beds and Jacuzzi tubs. All of the cabins but one have small balconies to enjoy the ocean views. Guests are well cared for by a crew of nine plus a naturalist guide. With only 16 passengers and an expert naturalist guide, each guest is ensured a personalized voyage. Because of the small groups, your expedition to the Galapagos can be at a much more leisurely pace.

### M/Y Estrella del Mar II



The M/Y Estrella del Mar II (formerly the Liberty) was designed for travelers who want to enjoy eco-tourism and diving in comfort. She is a single-hulled craft, 70 feet long, with a 20-foot beam, and cruises at 9 knots,

powered by twin engines. She accommodates up to 16 passengers in eight spacious cabins, all with twin lower berths and private bathrooms. Four upper deck cabins have windows, and 4 lower deck cabins have hatches. Guests are well cared for by a crew of seven plus a naturalist guide.

## 4, 5 & 8 Day-Cruises

The M/Y Estrella del Mar I is a Superior Tourist class, single-hulled craft, 75 feet long, with a 22-foot beam, and cruises at 9 knots, powered by twin engines. She accommodates up to 16 passengers in eight air-conditioned cabins with private bathrooms and lower berths. Two upper deck cabins have windows, and the other cabins on lower deck have hatches. Guests are well cared for by a crew of seven plus a naturalist guide.

The M/Y Antartida and M/Y Yolita are Tourist class, single-hulled motor yachts with accommodations for 10 and 12 passengers respectively. The cabins have upper/lower berths with private bathrooms and are not air-conditioned. These yachts are designed for the flexible traveler who seeks an alternative to the more luxurious ships without sacrificing privacy and comfort. They are approximately 55 feet long, with a 15-foot beam, cruising speeds of 8 knots, and are staffed with a crew of four plus a naturalist guide.
